Changing the Food Bank to a Community Pantry

There has been an emergency food bank at Christ Church every Monday and Wednesday since 2012. In the past year there has been a huge increase in client numbers, with the majority of our clients now regular visitors coming each week or month. They need extra food as they struggle to manage their income on Universal Credit or the State Pension.

Starting on 7th January we are going to become a community food store where clients can pay a nominal amount and buy a selection of food stuffs. This will give our clients more control over their budget, help their self-esteem, and remove some of the stigma attached to needing a food bank.

The Salvation Army will continue to provide emergency food parcels for those with no money.

The food bank volunteers are extremely grateful for the support received from the Catholic and Methodist congregations, and trust this support with food, money donations, and prayers will continue for the Community Pantry.
